







Nonfiction Conclusions and Story Endings

	<p>Question</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Leave the reader with a question to consider• ?
	<p>Quote</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Choose an important quote that brings closure to the piece• <i>“You have to be a friend to make a friend”</i>
	<p>Interesting Fact</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Choose an interesting fact that you discovered in your research• <i>Owning a pet can help you live longer!</i>
	<p>Memory</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Choose an important memory to share with the reader• <i>“I will never forget the time I won the spelling bee.”</i>
	<p>Tie Up</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Think about what questions the reader may still have about your piece and wrap-up any unanswered questions• <i>The mother turtle crawls out of the waves onto the sand.</i>
