



Arizona K-5 Literacy Endorsement Training

About the K-5 Literacy Endorsement Training (K-5 LET)

This 90-hour training course is required for K-5 classroom teachers, K-3 early childhood educators, interventionists, literacy coaches, and special education teachers. The training course must be completed by July 1, 2028. In addition to completing an approved course, a *Foundations of Reading* assessment taken through ADE must be passed. Information About the Course

The AZ K-5LET course totals 90 hours for the live format and 91 hours for the facilitated online format. A 460-page training manual is included. The course covers the following K-5 literacy topics organized into modules:

- Phonics
- Fluency
- Vocabulary
- Sentence Structure
- Text Structure
- Comprehension
- Students with Reading Difficulties
- Reading Assessment

The live format also includes a K-5 Writing module.

Format Options and Costs (note: these are 2022-23 school year rates)

<i>Format Option</i>	<i>Description</i>
Facilitated Online Course	This format combines 52 hours of asynchronous online course time with 15 hours of virtual-live meetings facilitated by a Keys to Literacy trainer (2.5 hours per meeting). Participants complete sections of the online course at their own pace, interspersed with virtual-live sessions. In addition, participants complete 24 hours of independent work that includes taking notes, writing summaries, and completing “connect to the classroom” activities based on reading supplemental texts and watching supplemental videos.

	<p>The training course is organized into 6 sessions. Each session takes 12.5 to 18 hours to complete. Schools/districts can schedule 1 or more sessions per year.</p> <p>At least one district-based facilitator must be appointed to be the liaison with KTL for developing and monitoring the PD plan over time, and to track participation/attendance of educators and awarding of course completion certificates. At the start of the course, KTL will provide a half-day training to district facilitators.</p>

Delivery can be virtual-live format using Zoom meeting, or onsite at the district. In addition, participants complete 24 hours of independent work that includes taking notes, writing summaries, and completing “connect to the classroom” activities based on reading supplemental texts and watching supplemental videos.</p> <p>The training course is organized into 12 days. Each day consists of 5.5 hours of time with the KTL trainer, plus 2 hours of independent work. Schools/districts can schedule 2 or more days per year.</p> <p>At least one district-based facilitator must be appointed to be the liaison with KTL for developing and monitoring the PD plan over time, and to track participation/attendance of educators and awarding of course completion certificates. KTL will provide a half-day training to district facilitators at the start of the course.</p>
