### As of Jan 1, 2023 Keys to Beginning Reading Facilitated Online Course District, SST, or ESC Level I Facilitators Guidelines for Dyslexia Support Teacher Professional Development

The Ohio Dyslexia Support requirement for all K-3 teachers and teachers providing special education instruction to children in K-12 is to complete a minimum of 18 hours in an approved course. *Keys to Beginning Reading* (KBR) is an approved course that takes the following amount of hours to complete when delivered by district, SST, or ESC certified Level I Facilitators:

• Facilitated-online training: 36 hours of online time plus 12 hours of facilitated live or virtual-live sessions (total 48 hours)

## Q: Do teachers have to complete the full KBR course to meet the requirement?

A: The ODE is leaving it up to districts to determine if teachers need to complete the full course or if completing the first 18 hours is sufficient. Level I Facilitators should check with the district for details.

## Q: How far into the KBR course does a teacher need to get to reach the minimum 18 hours?

*A:* For facilitated online training, teachers must complete up through Module 6 to cover the 18-hour requirement:

# Q: What information should the Level I Facilitator provide districts about participation/completion of KBR training?

A: <u>Level I Facilitators should take attendance</u> at facilitated sessions and make this information available to the school district.

<u>Completion of online course modules:</u> The Ohio Dyslexia Support online course is broken into two sections. After Modules 1-6, a Certificate of Completion for 30 hours can be downloaded

indicating successful completion of that part of the online course (22.5 for online time, 7.5 for facilitated meeting time). After Modules 7-11, a second Certificate of Completion for 13.5 hours of online time plus 5 hours of facilitation session time (18.5 hrs total) can be downloaded indicating successful completion of the full course.

#### Q: Can a teacher join a training cohort after the facilitated sessions have started?

A: Yes, but ONLY if the facilitator meets with the teachers to get them caught up on any facilitation meetings they missed **before** they join the cohort. To meet the Ohio Dyslexia Support Laws requirements teachers need to attend the facilitated sessions.

### Q: Does Keys to Literacy provide a Certificate of Completion?

A: As noted above, Certificates of Completion are accessed within the online course.

### Q: Can a participant earn graduate credit if they only complete Modules 1-6?

*A:* No. Participants that would like to earn graduate credit through the University of the Pacific must complete the FULL course (Modules 1-11). For more information regarding graduate credit please click on <u>this link</u>.
