



# Online Professional Development

Educators can access Keys to Literacy (KTL) professional development through our online training courses. Each course is organized into modules that include interactive activities, readings, video clips, and activities that allow users to master course content. Online courses are asynchronous which means users can complete the course at their convenience; they may log in at any time to work through the modules at their own pace. KTL also offers facilitated online options that combine an online course with virtual-live facilitated sessions with a KTL trainer using Zoom meeting. Contact KTL to learn more.
