



## Goal Setting Worksheet

Goals for Kindergarten - 5th grade are based on the composite score

An additional goal for grades 3rd through 5th or 6th grades can be based on state assessment scores in ELA

### Steps for Completing Table I:

Step 1: Complete Table I below by including the percentage of students proficient and above for each grade on the defined measures and place in Column 1.

Step 2: Increase the number in Column 1 by 10% and place in Column 2.

### Steps for Completing Table II:

Step 1: Enter into the table below the percentage of students scoring Advanced in Column A.

Step 2: Enter the percentage of students scoring Proficient in Column B.

Step 3: Enter the percentage of students scoring Below Benchmark in Column C.

Step 4: Add Columns A, B and ½ of Column C and enter that in Column D.

Step 5: Enter the percentage of students Well Below Benchmark in Column E.

Step 6: Enter ½ of the percentage of students in Column E into Column F.

Step 7: Enter the percentage from Table I, Column 2 into Column G.

Step 8: Compare the numbers in Column D and G and choose the higher number. Place this number in Column H. **Column H is the goal for EOY.**
