Steps for Completing Table II:

- Step 1: Enter into the table below the percentage of students scoring Advanced in Column A.
- Step 2: Enter the percentage of students scoring Proficient in Column B.
- Step 3: Enter the percentage of students scoring Below Benchmark in Column C.
- Step 4: Add Columns A, B and ½ of Column C and enter that in Column D.
- Step 5: Enter the percentage of students Well Below Benchmark in Column E.
- Step 6: Enter ½ of the percentage of students in Column E into Column F.
- Step 7: Enter the percentage from Table I, Column 2 into Column G.
- Step 8: Compare the numbers in Column D and G and choose the higher number. Place this number in Column H. Column H is the goal for EOY.
