

The Key Comprehension Routine: Guided Book Study

Are you interested in learning instructional practices for teaching comprehension strategies in any subject using a book study that you can complete independently? This guided book study is the solution!

What is The Key Comprehension Routine?

This instructional routine incorporates a combination of strategies for supporting comprehension of content and reading in any subject area. It is appropriate for educators in any subject area of students in grades 4-12. Instructional practices address these topics, strategies, and skills:

- Main idea skills: categorizing information and vocabulary, identifying main ideas at the paragraph level, and identifying central ideas in lengthier text
- **Text structure knowledge**: at the sentence, paragraph, and longer text levels
- **Top-down topic webs**: a graphic organizer that represents the major topics and big ideas of any content that is read, said, or done
- Two-column notes: a note taking format that supports active reading and listening
- **Summarizing**: students comprehend and synthesize the main ideas from any content that is read, said, or done
- **Generating questions**: students create and answer questions along a continuum of thinking using Bloom's Taxonomy based on content that is read, said, or done

What is the Guided Book Study?

The format for this professional learning is a do-it-yourself book study using *The Key Comprehension Routine* training book. You complete the independent learning at your own pace by reading chapters in the book, responding to reflection questions, and watching videos.

You begin by watching a 45-minute introductory video that provides an overview of *The Key Comprehension Routine*. The book study is then organized into four parts. For each part, you read assigned training book chapters, complete a set of reflection questions, and then watch a short, culminating video related to those chapters.

The reflection questions and videos, along with instructions for completing the independent books study, are accessed using the Keys to Literacy Teachable online book study site.

While this book study has been designed to be used by individual educators, it can also be used within peer learning communities to provide a shared professional development experience. A collaborative group can develop an agreed upon schedule for completing the readings for each part of the book study, and then share responses to the book study questions during collaborative meetings.
